TOP TIPS to help you control CO₂ in your classroom



Check your classroom air quality monitor often.

Use the table below and if CO₂ levels are climbing or high, ask your teacher to open some windows and doors.



CO₂ levels are highest just before break or lunchtime.

TIP

Before you leave your classroom open all windows and doors to clear the room of CO2 while the room is empty. Opening windows and doors on opposite sides of your classroom brings in more outdoor air.
